

<u>Quodlibet</u> — Table runner, Wall hanging or Lap Tuesday February 5th (5:30pm-8:30pm)

Judy will guide you through this pattern of flying geese, checkered boards, square in a square, zigzag, diamond in a diamond, funky rails and chevrons while creating a unique quilt.
